
COURT DINING ROOM

THE COURT DINING ROOM IS A FAVOURITE PLACE FOR INTIMATE LUNCHES AND CANDLELIT DINNERS. IT OVERLOOKS OUR HISTORIC GARDEN AND IS NEXT TO THE DRAWING ROOM WITH WHICH IT CAN BE COMBINED FOR LARGE RECEPTIONS.

This room stands in the oldest part of Drapers' Hall dating to the late 1660s though altered in 1869 by John G Crace whose family worked for every British monarch from George III to Queen Victoria. Its focal point is a portrait of Queen Elizabeth II who became a Draper in 1947, and whatever happens here, time is history, measured by a clock of 1715 by the celebrated Daniel Quare.


DRAWING ROOM

AN ELEGANT SETTING FOR CHAMPAGNE RECEPTIONS, AND LARGE AND LIGHT ENOUGH TO BE A FILM-MAKERS HEAVEN, THE DRAWING ROOM IS HUNG WITH DELICATE VICTORIAN CHANDELIERS AND RETAINS ITS ORIGINAL PALE GREEN AND CREAM COLOUR SCHEME OF THE 1860s.

It is also a good setting for presentations with sculpture busts of Queen Elizabeth II and HM The King, both members of the Drapers' Company, lending it appropriate formality.


COURT ROOM


LIVERY HALL

WHERE ONCE THOMAS CROMWELL, WHOSE MANSION STOOD ON OUR CURRENT SITE, STROLLED THROUGH ROSE BUSHES, FRUIT TREES AND HERB BEDS, YOUR GUESTS CAN ENJOY A HIDDEN OASIS IN THE HEART OF LONDON.

Much has changed since Cromwell's day but with mulberry trees, a water feature and flowers reflecting the azure and gold of the Drapers' Company coat of arms, our garden retains its sense of history.

The Drapers' Hall Garden is perfect for entertaining guests on warm evenings, comfortably holding up to 180 people for a drinks reception.

The Courtyard provides another separate outdoor space for evening receptions at Drapers' Hall, completely independent from the beautiful Drapers' Hall Garden.


